

15 cases of rape reported in a month

A total of 15 cases of woman rape were reported in a month across the country, shows a media monitoring report.

A media monitoring conducted by Sancharika Samuha Nepal (an organisation of women journalists) shows that 15 teenage girls and women were raped in a month (from June 16-July 16).

A total of 55 news [stories](#) about women violence made the [headlines](#) in the Nepali and English dailies in a month. National dailies — Kantipur, Nagarik, Naya Patrika, Gorkhapatra, Himalaya Times, Karobar, Rajdhani, Annapurna Post, Nepal Samacharpatra, Commander Post, Surya Dainik and English language dailies- The Kathmandu Post, The Himalayan Times, Republica and the Rising Nepal, were chosen for the monitoring. Of the reports, 15 were about rape.

The [violence against women](#) related news were categorized in 13 topics such as rape, sexual harassment, [domestic violence](#), women trafficking, murder, bigamy, torture on the practice of witchery and tortures against women in the name of religion, among others. RSS
